#### Dear friends.

Regarding the security aspects of the egroup that Aura has set up, I have the following comments:

- 1. As Aura has stated, the eGroup web site has a fairly good set of security safeguards, and we have to remember that anything that goes through or is connected to the Internet is never really secure nor private.
- 2. I do not anticipate our discussions to deal with very sensitive topics that will require a large measure of privacy. In any case, if a member of the group feels that a message that he wants to send should be private, then he can send it directly to Aura using Aura's e-mail address rather than replying to the egroup. Aura can then decide to send it to the rest of the group using their e-mail addresses rather than the egroup.
- 3. It will be easier for the moderator to manage the discussion group rather than with e-mail lists.
- 4. The site may be more reliable than an ordinary server hosting the group. There may be times when our networks or servers may be down, inaccessible or may have problems, but the eGroups site will mostly be available anywhere.
- 5. Perhaps we can have the sentiments of all of the members of the group about this issue so that we can decide whether to continue using the egroups or use e-mail lists.


