Sorry to take so long to get back to you. I believe some of my emails were lost in a crash of the LAN here, however, this one got through. I have also been busy with the end of the semester rush.

January is OK with Nigel and Len but I have two course teaching commitments in the winter and cannot get away after the first week of January. Nigel had previously suggested that August was OK and I am suggesting the week of August 13. Len will get back to me to confirm that that time is OK for him.

On the basis of our earlier proposal and your submission to CIDA, I have drawn up a program for the course.
