The Center for Educational Services, the Research Institute and Technopolis were assigned to arrange training programs requested. The fee for one person -month shadowing program will be US \$ 500*. Accommodation and board and air fare are not included.

Other Matters

Vietnam:

The Director of the Center for International Affairs reported to the meeting that there will be 72 grants to be given to students from Laos, Cambodia and Vietnam to study in universities in Thailand as part of the 72n Birthday Anniversary Celebration of His Majesty the King. The grant will include tuition, accommodation and board for 1 semester in a Thai university and air fare. Currently, there is a young Vietnamese faculty from HAU who has expressed interest to come to SUT for training in Technology and Equipment for Food Processing, specially on dairy processing.

During the last visit of the CiA Director to Vietnam to attend the educational fair, the Vietnamese students expressed interests in SUT's English language program while the faculty member from different universities are interested in Agriculture, and basic Sciences.

Cambodia

The CIA Director received a letter from Cambodia requesting for nomination of experts in the areas of Accreditation / Quality Assurance and University Finance Management for a duration of one month.

SUT is interested in assisting Cambodia in the two requested areas. More detailed consultations will be done later between the Rector and the CIA Director. The meeting adjourned: 10, 00 hrs.

SUT, therefore, will accept the applicants from Laos with educational background from the national University of Laos, Vietnam and Russia.

1.3 Assessment System

Due to unfamiliarity with the Russian assessment system, CIA was assigned to obtain information concerning the assessment system of Russia through either the Russian Embassy or SUT Russian faculty members. Same is true for Laos and Vietnam.

2. Conclusion:

- 2.1 The meeting agreed to conditionally admit the six applicants from Laos P.D.R. They will be requested to come for an interview at SUT prior to their admission. The information gained will help SUT further arrange their placement and academic programs. The institutes of Science and Agricultural Technology were assigned to cooperate with the CIA to organize the interview as soon as possible so that the students could start the program in term 3 beginning next January.
- 2.2 Like other applicants, the Laotian applicants will have to be responsible for the cost incurred for traveling to SUT for the interview. As they are under ADB's support the cost could be absorbed by the sponsor.
- 2.3 Due to their low English proficiency, the Laos applicants under ADB's support could attend the Thai Graduate program. It is understood that they may have some difficulties in writing Thai, but it is also believed that they will definitely improve their writing ability during their study in Thailand as the foundation of the two languages are very similar. Moreover, in some cases the Laos students can also write in their own language.
- 2.4 As for English course for Laotian students, it was agreed not to make any special arrangement for English tutorial for them. The Rector reiterated that the Laotian students will be treated in the same manner as other students in the same program.
- 2.5 The Dean of Institute of Science asked for information on general procedures for in application by foreign students. The Rector stated that all applications from both inside and outside Thailand will be handled by the Center for Educational Services. The CIA will be involved only when the applicants are under agreement or cooperation project.
