Thank you very much for your email of 20/3 I do apologize for the slight delay in the reply as I was on mission to Hanoi last week and did not return to SUT till yesterday.

I am most grateful for your inclusion of SUT, but I am afraid, I am not clear of the project as the inclusions which you mentioned could not be accessed.

Regarding the theme of the collaboration and possible activities, I am a bit vague about it and so perhaps, we can just agree with your regarding the proposal and we can workout the details. We will be willing to do either collaborative research or work with you in organizing workshops/seminars and training courses in collaboration with other Thai universities like Kasetsart, Khon Kaen, Prince of Songkla, Naresuan and even Burapha. There is also the possibility of working with other universities in the Philippines (UP) or in Indonesia and Vietnam. Thus, it will be easy for me to coordinate them. Needless to say, it will depend if the project is bilateral, i.e. between France and Thailand or it will be for the ASEAN region. There is revival of interest for the Greater Mekong Subregion as we just had a meeting and perhaps, it will be more interesting to work with this group.

Among the areas of interests could include: (1) Fish Genetics (2) Pond or Lake Water Quality Management and Hygiene (3) Fisheries Microbiology and Parasitology (4) Fish Nutrition (5) Fisheries Product Processing and Marketing (6) Other fisheries products aside from Fish – mollusks, crustaceans, etc (7) Indigenous Fishing Strategies (8) Sustainable Fisheries Development (9) Gender Issues in Fisheries Development (10) Fisheries Management in Wetlands

I do not think I will be able to come up with any definitive proposal before the 30th and so I will be just willing to work with you in the future on whatever project may be approved or considered.

Please read carefully and to react accordingly.

Within a very short notice, the French Ministry of foreign Affairs, jointly with the Ministry of Research of France, informed me about the general agreement between the Royal Thai Government and the French Government according to which common academic activities could be developed with an extra joint financial support of the two governments :

The projects to be considered for support have to fulfill the following conditions :

To develop networks of scientists/institutions of the two countries with common scientific interest under the coordination of networks leaders in the two countries .

A key field is agriculture in a very broad sense which includes fisheries

Various activities have to appear and particularly research training through Msc, PhD and/or post doctorate studies ; the organization of workshops or seminars as well as publication of available data are most welcome. We are encouraged to award joint degrees with co-tutorships

A budget has to be prepared with clear identification of what is already going on and what is requested specifically from the two governments. Various items can be applied for : trips, training periods abroad, seminars,. The proposals have to be approved and signed by the authorities of your institutions (Dean of the faculty or President of the University in our case)

The Projects proposals have to be submitted simultaneously in France and Thailand **before the 30th of March**, which is very short as you can realize.

Therefore, in order to save time, we did prepare the project proposal directly in English for application to the French government and here it is for your kind and careful consideration. As you will see, you are invited to edit it if you feel it is necessary (mostly for figures, costs...). I suggest that our colleagues from Suranaree University of Technology could be the leaders as SUT has a key role to play in this general framework of cooperation between France and Thailand.

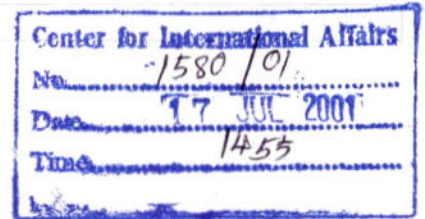
