1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- * A weighted general average in GPA and the core subjects, i e methematics and sciences of 3.00 or better
- * An English TOEFL score of at least 500
- * High school leaving certificate and scores in National Examination

2. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- * Mail to the Centre for International Affairs, Suranaree University of Technology the accomplished admission application form with a bank draft for baht 250 (U\$ 10) as application fee; academic records and certificate (High School Diploma), and four 2x2 photos on or before 30 March 1995.
- * For qualified pre-screening candidates an acknowledgement slip will be sent specifying the date, time and venue of the Qualifying Entrance Examination in English, Mathematics, Sciences and General Knowledge.
- * Candidates will be required to reconfirm their intention taking the exam by sending the accomplished form and bank draft of baht 300 (U\$ 12) as examination fee.
- * The results of the examination will be reviewed by the Admission Committee and would determine the students to be admitted of the program. The result will be made known the first week of May.
- * The successful candidate must confirm their registration by sending the acceptance form on or before the third week of May. Registration for the Intensive English Course will be the first week of June.
