

Prof. Dr. Wichit Srisa-an, Rector of Suranaree University of Technology at Nakhon Ratchasima, Thailand and member of the Senate of the Royal Government of Thailand, has requested me to seek the assistance of the New Zealand Embassy in arranging a proposed study tour of three to four days (dates and venue) by the members of the Committee on Education and Culture of the Senate of the Royal Government of Thailand during the latter half of February, 1997.
