

INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR WORKSHOP ON “ADVANCES IN WATER RESOURCES MANAGEMENT AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT TECHNOLOGIES”

RATIONAL AND OBJECTIVES

In pursuance of the mission of Suranaree University of Technology (SUT) of providing academic service to the public and various units, both government and private, the Center for International Affairs (CIA) is launching its International Life Long Education Program (ILLEP). Its aim is to provide continuing education opportunities to the general public but specially the engineers, scientists, entrepreneurs, and managers through short-term courses, seminars, conference, workshops, study tours and other forms of educational activities

With the collaboration of the Canadian University of Technology Consortium (CUTC) and partial financial assistance of the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA), SUT is organizing its first ILLEP seminar workshop on **“Advances in Water Resources Management and Wastewater Treatment Technologies”**.

Freshwater, either as surface or ground water, is a vital renewable community resource that is limited in amount and is subject to conflicting and ever increasing demand. An equitable distribution for domestic, industrial, agricultural, municipal and recreational uses is not always easy to attain

Proper water resources management which involves both quality and quantity assurance is a complex and enormous task requiring integrated activities of many sectors of the community and various government agencies. It involves different activities from provision of high quality potable water supply for domestic consumption to management of dams and reservoirs for agricultural and energy generation purposes, control of canals and drainage systems to prevent floods and conserve rain water, protection of ground water from salt water intrusion and seepage of wastes to even forest conservation.

Although there are usually local, national and regional water authorities, the integrated water resource management is a concern of many institutions and agencies. Data must be collected and analysed, researches undertaken, policies formulated, resources managed and wastewater treated. All these activities and many more would require corresponding trained manpower, a management information system and efficiently functioning organizational structure

Equally important is the issue of wastewater management. Sewage and industrial waste effluents must not pollute the aquatic ecosystems which are usually used as discharge points of these wastes. Technologies must be developed and applied so that polluting properties of wastewater could be minimized if not completely removed. It is through these recovery and treatment processes that sufficient quantity and good quality water can be assured.

The present seminar workshop which would also coincide with the celebration of the Sixth Founding Anniversary of Suranaree University of Technology, would provide a forum for the academe, industry, the government agencies and the general public

- to present the Canadian experience in comprehensive and integrated watershed management techniques including Canadian methods of environmental impact assessment used in water-related developments as well as industrial environmental auditing techniques;
- to survey and analyse the status, issues, strategies and policies concerning uses and management of water resources in the northeast and eastern seaboard regions of Thailand specially the role of industry and estate development companies;
- to present advances in wastewater treatment technologies and identify wastewater management options as well as policies applicable to the region, country and Southeast Asia;
- to foster close cooperation between various national and international sectors concerned with sustainable water resources development and wastewater management
