Thanks very much for your letter of December 17 sent to the Canadian Embassy. As it deals with educational issues, the Embassy staff forwarded it to my office for action.



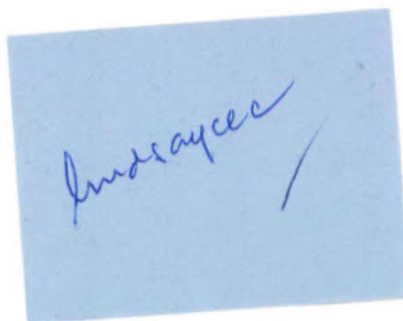
