## 1. Date and Venue :

## 3. Accommodation

## A. Bangkok

Since the meeting will be held in Phitsanuloke, a province about 380 kilometres north of Thailand, overseas participants are advised to arrive in Bangkok before or on November 9 and stay overnight at the Comfort Suites Airport Bangkok which is located 2 kilometres south of Bangkok International Airport. The MUA will reserve rooms at the hotel according to the participants' request. The single and double room rate is 1,300 baht or approximately \$US 38 (tax, service charges and Asian breakfast inclusive). Those who will not stay overnight in Bangkok can make connect flight to Phitsanuloke.



The international flight reservation should include domestic flights to and from Phitsanuloke so that your luggages could be checked through. The round trip airfares for domestic business and economy classes are 2,900 and 1,900 baht or approximately \$US 83 and \$US 55 respectively. Naresuan University will provide transportation from Phitsanuloke Airport to the Topland Hotel for the participants on November 9, 1997. Participants will be met at the exit door of the airport by the organizing staff. In case of missing Naresuan bus, participants are suggested to contact an information desk at the airport for a taxi to the hotel. The fare should not exceed 50 baht or approximately \$US 2 . A map locating the Topland Hotel is enclosed for your information.

Bus service will also be provided free of charge to and from the Topland Hotel - Naresuan University.

## C. Departure

Naresuan University will provide transportation from the Topland Hotel to Phitsanuloke Airport for participants on November 12, 1997. Participants wishing to continue their stay in Phitsanuloke can contact the hotel information desk for transportation to the airport.
