RE: SUT PARTICIPATION IN 1998 ISP (ISU)

We were informed by ISU that our staff Assoc. Prof. Rangsan Wongsan has been admitted to the 1998 ISP and will receive full support from ISU. We will however be responsible for air fare and for the balance of the equivalent per diem from SUT, i.e. the per diem to be given by ISU is much smaller than that allowed by SUT. Thus, there is a request for additional support.

Ms. Mantana of CIA has also been granted grant to be with the course as part of the logistical staff so that she would learn the everyday running of the program. She will thus be there too for the entire course. She will also need air fare and the balance of per diem similar to Prof. Wongsan.

There is a partial grant available for another SUT staff. There was a staff from Industrial Technology who also applied. She was recommended by Dr. Sart who attended the course before. However, she is only a temporary staff and she has resigned effective 1st of May. Thus, we have to inform ISU that she is no longer a staff of SUT. Are we going to look for a substitute for her? The grantee will get only half of what Prof. Rangsan will get and therefore the obligation of SUT will be bigger. I do not know if we need another one.

There was also a proposal from us that representative of CIA and/or Technopolis should also go for a short visit. They may also observe how the course is run and at the same time give a lecture. I can give a lecture in Radiation Biology while Ajarn Manu can give a lecture in Remote Sensing. However, Dr. Neung has also expressed interest of going to observe. I do not know how much budget we can still afford. At least one has been budgeted for 1998.

I shall be most grateful for your kind advice regarding this matter so that we can send the reply to ISU and for our participants to prepare for their departure.
