1. Review of the Minutes of Previous Meeting (02/3.5.95)

Prof. Dr. Wichit Srisa-an as the chairman of the committee reviewed the minutes of last meeting on 3 May, 1995. He asked all committee members to consider the agenda.

2. Review of the Results of IUP Examination

The chair asked all members of the committee to review the results of IUP Exam in English and Basic Sciences of the second batch which were distributed at the meeting. The eleven(11) candidates out of 24 accepted are listed below by score order :

3. Finalization of list of accepted students

From the first batch of 2 successful candidates out of 16, only 2 confirmed their intentions to enroll at IUP, one in Chemical Engineering and the other in Food Technology. Of the 11 additional successful candidates from the second batch, 7 for Mechanical Engineering, 1 for Chemical Engineering and 3 for Food Technology. Therefore 13 successful candidates were accept to enroll at IUP.

4. IUP Program to be offered in 1995

Because the majority of accepted had Mechanical Engineering or their first Choice, the Committee has decided to offer the Mechanical Engineering program for 1995. The few students who applied for Chemical Engineering and Food Technology all be informed accordingly and asked to transfer to Mechanical Engineering if so desired.

5. Fee of Intensive English Course

The Chair asked all members to find out the suitable fee for the Intensive English Course. The committee agreed to set the fee at 5,000 bath. The Intensive English Course need not be limited to IUP students but can also be opened to others.

6. Other Matters

6.1 The Third Batch of IUP

Dr. Prasart Suebka suggested to open a third batch of IUP students to SUT Regular (Thai program) freshmen. He would announce during the orientation program in the afternoon of 15 June, that the IUP committee will screen freshmen using their score of English Placement test to determine whether they can qualify for transfer to the International Program.

6.2 The Lecturer for teaching Intensive Course

Prof. Dr. Umaly asked the chairman about the assignment of Ms. Judy Hunter from CUTC to Intensive Course.

It was agreed upon that due to the small number of students, and the assignment of two American lecturers between in the English Department, There is no need to catch her here this year.
