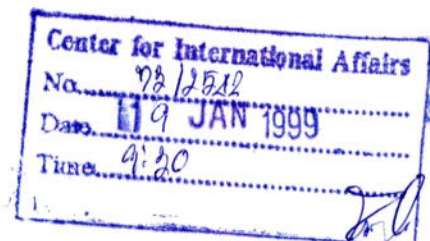

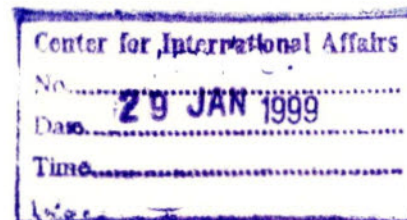

Dear Egay,

Thank you for your letter with CV. I am glad that you applied for the ISU program in Strasbourg. However, the Summer Session that will be held at our University may also be a good chance for you. This will also enable you to follow up your application at AIT and to see our SUT Remote Sensing program. It is still a very new one and so I do not know how good it is. At present, I have two scholarship quota for the summer program at SUT of ISU. I intend to recommend somebody from Thailand for one and I can recommend you for the Philippines. Thus, what I can advise you is to fill up immediately the form and send it to ISU in France. If you do not have the form you can print it out from the website: <http://w.w.w.isunet.edu> or www.ISU.net. edu/Academic/ssp. I will be sending you by mail the forms and brochure. The representatives of ISU will be coming to SUT the first week of February and I can mention to them your application. I am not promising anything, but we have nothing to lose.

Regarding the return to academe, I have a proposal to make for a post, but there is no hurry for it. It may have something to do when I return to the Philippines. I may need an assistant with your qualifications. However, I will still have to discuss a few things with the President of the University regarding the post and salary. There is no hurry. Meanwhile, it will also be good to pursue your Ph.D. and I know the head of the Remote Sensing Dept. at AIT. I will find out about available grants. I will be lecturing at AIT during the first week of February and I will meet the Filipino Vice President for Academics and so I will find out what is delaying your acceptance at AIT and what possible scholarships are available.

I may be visiting Manila during the second week of February and so I will give you a call and perhaps we can meet for lunch or dinner. I will most likely be staying at Sulo Hotel in Quezon city and so it will not be too far from your place.

Meanwhile, fill up the application form for ISU SSP 99 at SUT and you can use my name as reference in your application. Although the first deadline is February, you can still apply now!

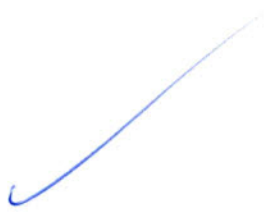

Dear Rangsan:

I'm sorry that I haven't been in contact with you recently. I'm sure you've been busy and I've been busy, too!

Let me start off by saying that with the current money situation here at ISU, the field trip is in danger of being cancelled. In fact, unless we get about 110 students, there probably won't be a field trip. If we **do** get 110 students or so, then there might be a chance that the field trip will be reinstated, but even then, it's not a sure thing.

I wanted to show you the numbers I've been working with in determining the cost of the field trip. If while reading this you see that I'm using incorrect figures somewhere, could you please let me know so I can correct my math? That might make the difference between being able to take the students on a field trip or not!

I guess I'm thinking that we'd go to Pataya for the field trip, since that seemed like the location that all of us (you, me, Sart, Gretchen) were focussing on. It also seemed to be the cheapest of the available locations!

Here goes my estimation of costs ...

TRANSPORTATION

I figured that it would cost 20,000 THB for a 43-person bus to take our students to and from (round-trip) Pataya. Since there are about 150 people going (110 students + 40 staff and faculty), that means we would need 4 buses.

Transportation Cost: 20,000 THB/bus * 4 buses = 80,000 THB

FOOD

If we gave everybody about 100 THB/day for food for two days, that should be enough for people to live, shouldn't it? If I'm right, then...

100 THB/day * 2 days * 150 people = 30,000 THB

LODGING

You were looking into inexpensive lodging and were coming up with about 800 THB/night, if I'm not mistaken. If that was indeed the case, maybe we can put 3 people in a room each night...

$800 \text{ THB/night} * 2 \text{ nights} * 150 \text{ people} / 3 \text{ people/room} = 80,000 \text{ THB}$

Food	30,000 THB
Lodging	80,000 THB

That's about 30,000 French Francs...

Please let me know if my cost assumptions are alright and if I can make any

other cuts to bring the cost down (4 people per hotel room?!?)...

Thanks for your help with this matter, Rangsan... we'll figure *something* out!
