Dear Dr. My Loc,

Firstly, kindly extend my heartiest congratulations to your husband for his recent appointment as President of VNU. I hope I will be able to meet him during the workshop, if not earlier. I also hope that there will be opportunities for me to work with VNU specially in the projects of SDC and of your Faculty. He is also supposed to replace Dr. Dao as Board Member of the Association of Universities of Asia and the Pacific. He is representing Vietnam in the Board. I hope he will find the time to attend the coming Board meeting this month in Bangkok. I have requested Mme Quy to inform him about this.

Regarding the workshop, the week of the 13th is okay with me. During our original discussion, you mentioned that you want to develop a strategic plan for the Faculty and that you will be inviting the heads of the Divisions plus other key personnel to do the planning.
