I am pleased to inform you that the Institution of Engineers, Indonesia (PII), who is organizing the AEESEAP Triennial Conference in Bali on 23-25 August 2000, has accepted to host the third Working Group meeting of Engineering Component of ASEAN Virtual University of S&T (VUST) on 22 August just before the AEESEAP Conference.

As one of the main themes of the AEESEAP Conference is "Virtual University", I considered it appropriate to convene the third Working Group meeting on the occasion of the AEESEAP Conference. PII will be issuing the second announcement in the middle of May and you will be receiving from Dr Trihono copy of the announcement.

The UNESCO Jakarta Office has established a contract with the Faculty of Engineering of Culalongkon University (Dr Tatchai: fnetsm@eng.chula.ac.th) to sponsor the second Working Group Meeting of the ASEAN Virtual Engineering University. The Working Group members, who are not resident in Bangkok, will receive on their arrival at Bangkok through Dr Tatchai a travel grant (cost of economical return air ticket, two-day UN daily subsistence allowance of US\$109 per day and miscellaneous expenses of US\$100).
