RE: POSSIBLE LINKAGE WITH SUT

Thank you for your letter together with the MOU proposal. I have submitted it to Dr. Wichit as you requested. However, the University Council's approval is required before any MOU can be signed by the Rector. The usual procedure is for reciprocal visits to be made so that specific projects could be agreed upon. Normally, SUT does not enter into MOU without specific activities to be undertaken.

Dr. Wichit of course would be very glad to enter into agreement with AFU specially in the field of engineering and computer technology. However, his advise is for us to wait until the general umbrella of cooperation between Thailand and the Philippines is signed. We are presently renegociating a date for the visit of Minister Boonchu Trithong to Manila to sign an MOU with Dr. Angel Alcala. Dr. Wichit will be joining the party of the Minister. Part of that agreement will also the possible linkages of SUT with some universities in the Philippines. They have already suggested, TUP in Manila, San Carlos University in Cebu and IIT in Mindanao. I see no reason why AFU cannot be included to represent Central Luzon.

Regarding the University Management Seminar Workshop, I discussed it with Dr. Pareja in Penang. There are a number of issues in university management that were discussed during the Penang meeting. Perhaps some of those could be the topics of the seminar workshop. It is also suggested that perhaps this could be done during summer or semestral break as aside from the seminar it is suggested that a study tour be also included. We could arrange for the team to visit some universities in



Thailand- Chulalongkorn in Bangkok, Chiang Mai University in the North and Prince of Sungkla in the south and of course SUT in the northeast.

This workshop would need some planning and so I would appreciate receiving feedback from you ASAP.
