
I am waiting for the copy of the proposed MOU between SUT and AUF.

In this connection, we would like to invite the participation of QUENECO for someone to give a paper for plenary session or to serve as chair in discussion on water treatment


industries. This will give you an opportunity to meet not only people in the academe but also from industries and government agencies involved in water and wastewater management.
