I just got back today from a one-week visit to China to partly supervise the field research of my Chinese Ph.D. student from Guizhou University. During my visit the Director for International Affairs has expressed the desire and plan of their President and Vice President to visit Chiang Mai possibly for three days (two nights) to see Chiang Mai as well as to visit Maejo University and Chiang Mai University. They have a good Agricultural Institute as part of the University. The planned visit will be around the 25 to 28 of July. They will be staying at a hotel at their own expense, but I would be most grateful if you could provide some hospitality in the form of transportation during the visit to your University, provide a briefing of your programs, tour the campus and discuss possible cooperation.

I shall be most grateful for whatever kind assistance you may extend them regarding this matter.
