thank you for arranging the flight to Nakhon Ratchasima.

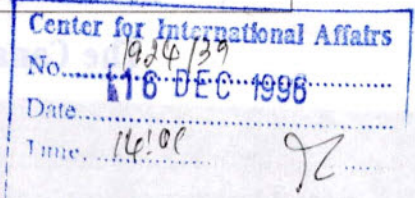
I will be returning to Bangkok on the evening of Thursday October
