

Thank you very much for your email of 4 December. I do apologise for the slight delay in the response as I was in Tasmania from 5 to 12 December for the AUAP General Conference. Then I had to proceed to Kuala Lumpur for another Conference which AUAP is co-organizing with UTM and SEAMEO RIHED. It was only today that I returned to the office. I am sorry I did not get your email before I left for Bangkok on the 4th.

I reported in Tasmania the collaboration between AUAP and ABEF and APHEIT in the June Conference on Business Ethics in Phuket Thailand and the Board has endorsed further collaboration with ABEF in future conferences. I also discussed this with Dr. Manit who is now with Rangsit University. We were the original organizers with Dr. Moliono of Indonesia during the first Bangkok ABEF Conference.

Yes, AUAP is willing to be a co-sponsor and we can publicize the conference to AUAP members with faculties of Business Administration. However, with the financial constraints in almost all countries in the region, we could not guarantee nor promise your required number of 20. Some of us will attend the conference and we will publicize it in our meetings and in our Gazette, but we will not be able to commit any exact minimum number of participants.
