#### Application

Please submit a short letter, preferably in electronic form, including:

Title of Paper for which you are submitting an abstract.

Your name and full contact details (address, tel, fax and e-mail).

Justification for why you need financial support and why coming to this meeting is important for you or your project.

Please indicate clearly the extent of any partial financial support you may already have to attend the meeting, such as project grants. For example, if you can pay 1/2 your travel costs from your grant or can pay the airfare, but would like us to pay for your accommodation. This is particularly important for people coming from developed countries outside the region.

A concise Curriculum Vitae (CV) or biographical sketch of not more than 2 pages in total.

Please submit all documents as rich text format (.rtf), word documents (.doc) or ASCII text files (.txt) to Connie Chiang ([connie@start.or.th](mailto:connie@start.or.th)) before 31 October 2000. Early submissions are welcome.

#### Selection

Applications for financial support to participate in the conference will be evaluated by a committee, on the basis of the submitted abstract and application above. Priority will be given to participants from developing countries in Southeast Asia. Partial support may also be offered in some special cases. Applicants will be notified in November.
